Lunchtime: Despite Covid, LOTS of FUN and learning this year!! QUIZ Rally actually happened in person the end of Feb 2020! Yay! Several mounted clinics and MULTIPLE certifications happened this year!! We missed some general meetings, but were able to hold many study sessions in small socially distanced group gatherings, and our annual parent sponsor meeting was a success in September!

Summary of 2020:

The year started with our first CERTIFICATION Date! USPC requires 2 a year...Remembering: in 2018 we held 6 certifications, 2019 we had 10 certification dates, and this year, even with Covid, VERY happy to have held 6 certification dates with 22 candidates testing on 52 different tests!!! Well done y'all!!!

Jan 4th: C2 HM only: Emily C2 HM!! Vanessa C2 HM and Alissa M C2 HM!! This is your Last LOCAL HM level certification...next horse management test is the infamous "HB", a national rating up in Racine, which, praise the Lord, I passed this August! Melissa passed it last year, so you have help within the club!! Alissa M may be going for HB in 2021!! YES!!! YOU CAN DO IT~~ Anyone else, LMK? The club is NOW sponsoring your national ratings with a \$200 scholarship / national test!!! Go for it!!

Also on Jan 4 Cert: Emily C1 Flat, and Emma W completed her D3 HM!! Woo hoo!! We'll get back to certifications...but next up this year was

Jan 10-11: 2 day <u>unmounted training extravaganza</u>..Remember this?? Fri and Saturday!! Suwanski's Fri night (THANKS AGAIN FOR HOSTING!) then Res Ranch Sat 8 to noon...2021 we will just have the Saturday session at Res Ranch, again 8 a.m. to noon.

- We all Learned a ton...members presented numerous topics...great prep for Quiz Rally and Horse Management part of certifications!!

 - Unmounted training: HANDS ON!! Excellent job~
 - Cs: Melissa, Katie, Jessie, Olivia, Alissa M, Vanessa, and Emily! Covered teeth to lunging, to cleaning stalls to conformation!! Well done!
 - Parent meeting held to kick off 2020 from 11:30 to noon!! THEN...

Jan 18th: Dressage Mounted Clinic by Jane~ Fundraiser!! GREAT learning!! Thank you, Jane! Members Participating: Vanessa, Alissa M, Emily, Jessie, Melissa, Olivia H, Lilly, Alyssa S, Gabrielle, Addie, Vicky and Lisa, Mia, Olivia S, Elizabeth, Lexie...Remember infamous Sarah Coltrin's advice (our B grad from 2017): *learn as much as you can from as many different instructors as you can, to improve as much as you can!*

Jan 25: 2nd Certification of 2020: unrated to D1s and D2 HM!! So we had 9 newby's getting their first pony club rating: Ella M, Connor, Kylie, Lexie, Olivia S, and Teagan!

Also testing for D2 HM only: Alina, Claire, Giana, Lucy, and Mia! studying gets tougher the higher your HM goes! As do the riding standards, of course...

End of Feb we got in Regional Quiz Rally in Peoria!! Who's planning to participate in VIRTUAL quiz rally in 2021 besides Mary K, leading by example: \$25 scholarship to each who participate in Quiz!

As we know...Covid slowed us down for March-April-May, but many of y'all enjoyed the 13 HM quizzes we sent out! I wrote 10 of them, plus Emily, Alissa M, and Addie!!! Prizes to all who participated afterwards. AND SPECIAL prizes for Quiz high scorers: Emily, Alissa M, Addie, Lexie, Gianna, Mia, and Emmalynn! Rank/ oldest to youngest will have it's privilege when picking the prizes...

By June, our barn opened up! PTL! We were back to nearly regular riding schedule!! Yay!

We held two mounted clinics in June which many of y'all participated in!!

- June 9 Jump Clinic a GO with Nikki Jewel, accomplished Show Jumper from the area, excellent training and hope to have her back in 2021
- June 19, Flat Clinic a GO with Kim Volmer, National Examiner!!

In 2021: Working on another Jane dressage clinic (we can never get enough dressage training!), plus Nikki Jewel jump clinic and Marlie Nauta clinic with both dressage and jumping!

June 25-26 in KY: Melissa passed her <u>National Certification B level</u>, Phase 1 with Bonnie!! Congrats! Tough cross country water preliminary level jump kept them from passing Phase 2 so retest hopefully in 2021 at Racine Aug 10ish!

August 10-14 in Racine, WI: Mary passed her National HB level, Woohoo!!! but not completely the C3 Eventing test on Manny...planning to retest in 2021, maybe C3 Dressage this time! I met Erin (age 22) at my C3, she was testing her 6th time for C3 and she passed!! Patient Persistence with LOTS more PRACTICE will Prevail! What a great example for US!

So back to Local Certifications, #3 and #4 in **July**: D2 eventing for Elsa C, Olivia S, Lexie, Kylie, Emmalynn, Gianna, and Mia!

And #5 Certification, August 29: D1 and D2 for NEWEST member Ana A, and Connor passed his D2 as well! D3 HMs passed by Addie, Viv, and Mia; Gianna and Lexie once record book up to speed, and Emmalynn retesting a few blocks of D3 HM soon!

Final Local Certification this year, #6, Oct 3 Certification with Marlie Nauta, National Examiner from WI: Passed: C2 Flat and Jump: Alissa Melville! Congrats!! Some retesting coming for Olivia's C2 Flat and jump on tough boy, Jordy when she is ready for it in 2021; C1 HM and flat passed by Alyssa Suwanski on Jordy! C1 Jump by Emily needs one item retest which we hope to do over Christmas break! D3 Dressage passed with flying hoofs and colors by Lisa and Vicky!! D3 Flat was successful by Addie, Mia, and Viv, although Marlie did mention to CLEAN YOUR BITS!! After every ride, right everyone?!

Whew!!! So we were really busy this year with Pony Club, despite Covid, despite missing a few general meetings, and the riding rallies up in Hampshire...

We plan to start 2021 with a certification January 2, LMK if you would like to test your next HM or flat or stadium jumping phase and I'll get you on the schedule!

- GREAT to have goals and then WORK HARD to accomplish them!
- If we don't pass completely the first time, there's always RETESTS!
 YAY~Life skills in pony club!
- It's OK to plan to stay at D3 or C2 level...no requirement in pony club to keep advancing, but fun to have the goals if that's YOU!
- Study hard for HMs and you'll make it happen!!
- Time in the saddle is needed more and more as you advance...Jane, our resident riding expert A level pony club graduate from the UK says:
 - plan to ride once a week for D level, that's great.
 - Plan 6 times a month to achieve C1,
 - Plan 8-12-15 times a month for C2 and higher levels!

- Just like any sport, riding takes repetition to teach your muscles how to perform! More you work at it, the better you get, along with a positive, teachable spirit!!
- PLUS, keep working on YOUR CORE STRENGTH!! We expect our horses to be strong to perform, that goes for the riders too!!
