## Other fee considerations:

- \* Ratings, camp, and regional rallies are fee-based.
- Books are required for each rating level and may be purchased from the USPC Bookstore. More books are recommended.
- Rulebooks for disciplines are available online or through the USPC Bookstore, along with periodic updates. The club provides USPC Standards of Proficiency and rating test sheets.
- Pony Clubbers are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets at all mounted activities. These cost about \$50 and up. Horse tack and apparel must meet requirements in rally rulebooks and Standards of Proficiency.
- Clothes with the SJPC logo (sweatshirts, sweat pants, polo shirts, jackets) are available for purchase periodically and a maroon polo is the required uniform. The first Pony Club pin is provided to new members.
- Mounted clinics may cost more than the fees collected with dues, depending on instructor, location, or the number of clinics scheduled.
- Opportunities for fundraising are available based on parent involvement. Funds raised can offset the cost of ratings, camp, and rallies.
- Dues support monthly meetings and other costs incurred in running the club.
